If I am having a really hard day I still put on those same pajamas and feel some comfort knowing I am not alone.

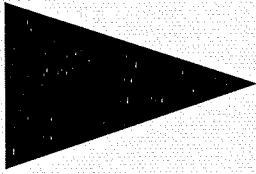
